## How to Reach?

### 1. By Air:

- Nearest Airport: Indira Gandhi International Airport (DEL) in Delhi.
- **Distance:** Approximately 50 km.
- Transport Options from the Airport:
  - Taxi: You can book a cab via services like Uber or Ola.
  - REI Shuttle: Shuttles arranged from Airport to Venue. Schedule (Click Here)
    Shuttle Helpdesk at 85277 78480, 82953 53835
  - Airport Shuttle: Some hotels offer shuttle services to Greater Noida.





#### 2. By Train:

- Nearest Railway Stations:
  - New Delhi Railway Station: You can take a taxi or metro from here.
  - Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Station: Similar transport options as above.
  - Local Trains: Check for local trains to Greater Noida or nearby stations like Dadri.

#### 3. By Road:

• Route 1 : Via Ring Road New Delhi

Take the DND (Noida Toll) bridge and approach Greater Noida exit after the toll booths. Continue past Film City and onto the Expressway.

- Route 2: Via Mathura Road Apollo Hospital Kalindi Kunj
  Drive past the Apollo Hospital & take left for Kalindi Kunj to reach Amity flyover & take loop to get on the Expressway.
- Route 3 : Via Ghaziabad NH24 Mayur Vihar

Take NH 24 and continue left from Akshardham Setu on Mayur Vihar – Noida road, through the DND underpass. Continue past Film City and onto the Expressway.

- Bus Services: There are state-run and private buses from Delhi and surrounding areas to Greater Noida.
- REI Shuttles: For the convenience of our visitors, team REI has arranged shuttle services from various location from and around Greater Noida, Delhi, New Delhi and Airport. Check out the shuttle schedule at (Click Here) or call Shuttle Helpdesk at 85277 78480, 82953 53835
- Google Maps and Taxi apps: Easy to find! Search "Renewable Energy India Expo" on Google Maps or your favourite taxi app.

### 4. By Metro:

- Metro Route: (Click Here)
- **Noida Metro:** You can take the Noida Metro to the Sector 137 station and then take REI Shuttle or hire a taxi or auto-rickshaw to the venue.

#### **EVENT RELATED GENERAL GUIDELINES OR ADVOSIRY FOR THE VISITORS**

While visiting the Exhibition, the visitors are requested (at all the time) to: -

- 1. This badge is valid for India Expo Center, Greater Noida only on event days.
- 2. The badge is not valid for entry if torn or disfigured.
- 3. Carry the E badge (received through email or SMS) and present the same for scanning purpose while entering the exhibition. No entry in the exhibition will be granted in the absence of valid E badge.
- 4. This badge is for personal use only and is not transferable.
- 5. Individuals below 18 years of age and infants in arms are strictly not allowed inside the exhibition hall.
- 6. Individuals must present a valid, current government-issued photo ID proving their identity at any entry point, as requested by the organizer or its assigned staff at any given point within the venue.





- 7. The rights of admission are reserved with the organizers
- 8. The organizers reserve the right to frisk the badge holders at the entrance and exhibition venue for security reasons. Your co-operation is solicited.
- 9. The badge must be worn and displayed prominently at all times during your stay at the exhibition site.
- 10. Entry restricted for attendees wearing shorts, Baniyan & Slippers.
- 11. Avoid spitting anywhere while inside the exhibition venue. A fine of INR 1,000/- will be payable, including other disciplinary action at the organizers sole discretion will be taken for failure to follow the rule.
- 12. Cameras, bottles, cans or tins are not allowed inside the exhibition venue.
- 13. Photography & videography is strictly prohibited without prior written permission from the organizers.
- 14. Food & Beverages are not permitted to be taken in the exhibition hall.
- 15. The organizers do not take the responsibility for the loss or theft of any personal belongings. Any theft /loss of the same will not be entertained by the organisers under any circumstances.
- 16. The consumption of banned substances (cigarettes, chewing tobacco, electric cigarettes) is strictly prohibited inside the exhibition venue.
- 17. Students from relevant industries with valid institute ID (only 18 years and above) will be granted entry from 12.30 p.m. onwards in India Expo Center, Greater Noida 05th October 2024 only.
- 18. Follow all applicable guidelines as are printed on the backside of the visitor's badge or exhibitor's booking form including visitor's terms and conditions as are provided under Informa's official website www.informamarkets.com, as amended from time to time.
- 19. The event is subject to force majeure conditions.
- 20. While visiting the Exhibition, the visitors are requested to comply with all COVID -19 related guidelines, issued by the Central & State Government authorities, as amended from time to time.
